Oil Gator biodegrades hydrocarbons on golf courses, even in the presence of HERBICIDES, PESTICIDES AND FUNGICIDES. Herbicides and pesticides, in *diluted concentrations*, such as you would have if the herbicide or pesticide were being applied in a golf course application will not significantly inhibit the micro-organisms in Oil Gator. Oil Gator will degrade the unwanted hydrocarbons like gas, oil, and transmission fluid.

Oil Gator will degrade hydrocarbons in the presence of *diluted concentrations* of fungicides. Fungicides present in the soil at strengths necessary to kill fungal growth in St. Augustine grass will slow the bacterial growth. However, Oil Gator or Floor Gator will recover and continue to degrade the unwanted hydrocarbon which has been absorbed.

NOTE: If you are dealing with the spill of concentrated pesticide, herbicide or fungicide, it is recommended that you encapsulate and solidify the liquid with Oil Gator or Floor Gator and dispose of it in accordance with local environmental regulations.
